Letter for Y12 and Y13 parents/carers

Dear parent/carer

With results day fast approaching, here are some key points regarding safety on the day:

- It is important that anyone with coronavirus symptoms, or who have someone in their household who does, does not attend school
- In order to minimise contact and mixing as far as possible, we are still planning on inviting small groups of students in at allocated times
- It is important that students do not gather outside the school doors with others that are not part of their group. Staff and students will be expected to socially distance at all times using the [current government guidance on social distancing](#)

Family members and friends will **not** be able to attend on the day.

The results that the students will collect are the final grades from the exam boards. Schools were asked to submit centre assessed grades and a rank order list. The exam boards will have then standardised the grades using a statistical model developed with Ofqual. Ofqual are The Office of Qualifications and Examinations Regulations and they regulate qualifications, examinations and assessments in England.

And finally, a reminder of the arrangements for the day:

Students will enter through the gate at the front of the building that is between TOA and Mabel Pritchard School. There will be a member of staff waiting to welcome them and show them into the library. Students will then collect their results, have an opportunity to talk to staff if they wish or need any support with their next steps. Students will then leave through the side door of the library. There will be a member of staff collecting destination information for Y13 students as they leave.

You will receive a text message to confirm your son/daughter's allocated time.
